



WORKSHOP 2 Where do we want to go?

The vision “in a nutshell”

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) – SDG1&10 (No Poverty & Reduced Inequalities), SDG8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth) and SDG13 (Climate Action) – are **set into relation to each other** and should be implemented in such a way that they consider:

- **further social goals** in order to guarantee sustainable **community cohesion**,
- **ecological goals** in order to comply with **planetary boundaries**.

Other social goals include e.g. **work-life balance**, **gender equality** and the **enhancing the value of care work**, which should create space for more personal involvement in the community and for maintaining meaningful relationships.

Other ecological goals include the **preservation of biodiversity** and the **conservation of resources in the sense of a circular economy**.

These objectives can only be achieved if the following institutional objectives are pursued:

- an **education** that produces *responsible and critical citizens through free access to holistic education and the anchoring of education for sustainable development*;
- increased **transparency** with regard to the environment, wealth/income and democracy, e.g. *through institutionalised monitoring based on a broad selection of social and environmental indicators*, and
- **governance** in which *citizens' councils* have the power to decide on policy-making measures and a *Climate Court of Audit* monitors compliance with agreed climate targets.

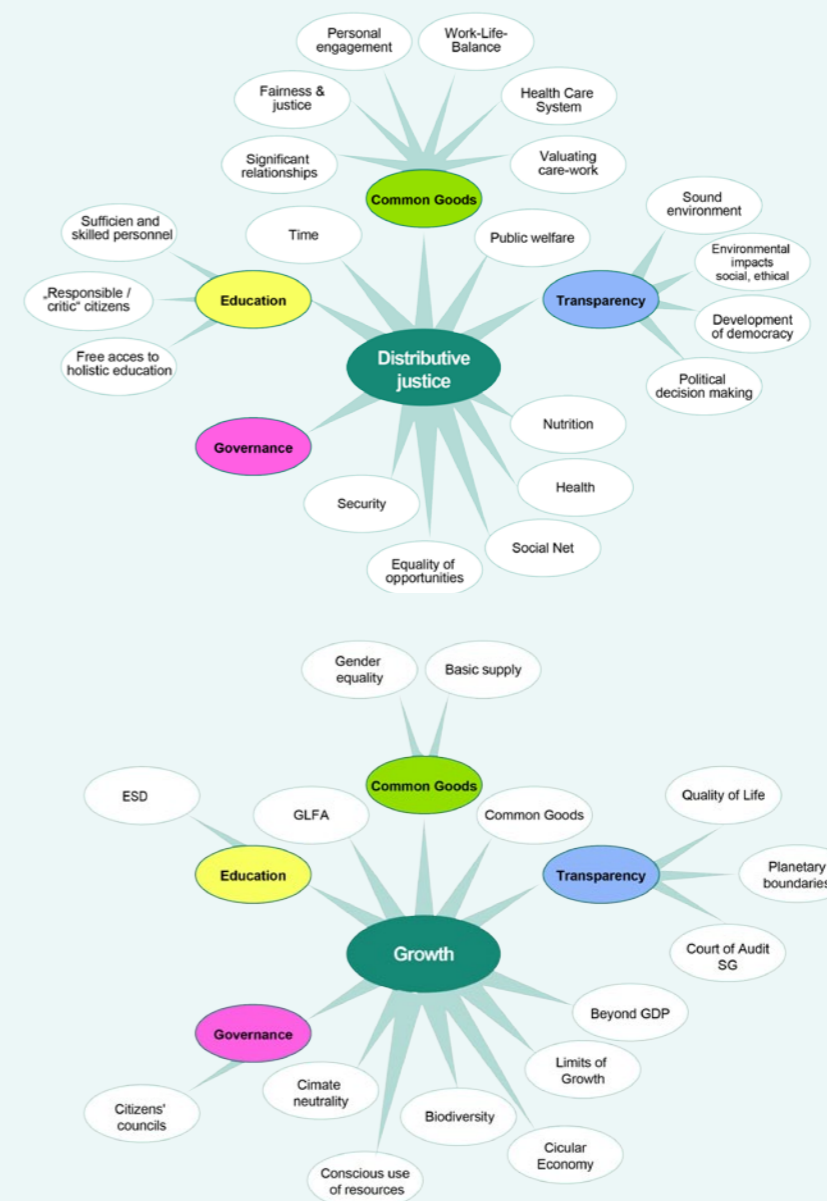


Figure: Illustration of the participants' visions and goals
